UNLESS **Unless** I study, I will fail. I will fail **unless** I study.

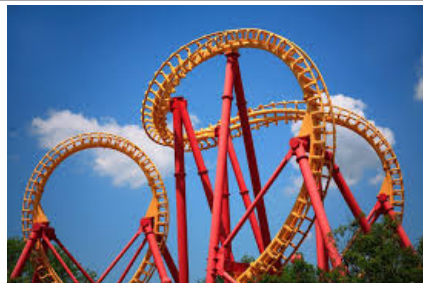
BECAUSE **Because** I studied, I earned an A.

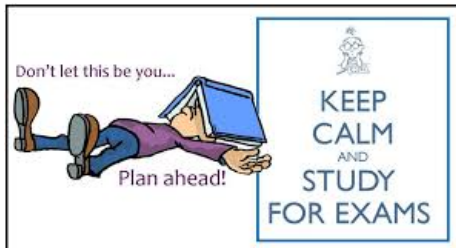
