

# Adjective Strings



An adjective string is formed when two separate adjectives describe the same noun but **DO NOT** have the word "**and**" between them.

**Instead**, a **comma** is inserted between the two adjectives.

## Examples:

The hot **and** spicy chicken was delicious.

The hot**,** spicy chicken was delicious.

The devoted **and** tireless nurse helped her patient.

The devoted**,** tireless nurse helped her patient.

While either example from the previous slide would be grammatically correct, the ones using adjective strings (~~delete the "and" ~ replace with a comma~~) tend to get the reader's attention and make a stronger impression.
