Or → On the other hand,

Good vs Well

"Good" is an adjective (what kind?):

She is a good student.

"Well" is an adverb (how?):

He did well on the test.

Rules for capitalizing school subjects:

- ★ **do not** capitalize common nouns in sentences such as **r**eligion, **m**ath, **s**cience, **s**ocial **s**tudies
- ★ **DO** capitalize subjects that refer to countries (proper nouns) such as **S**panish, **F**rench, **E**nglish
