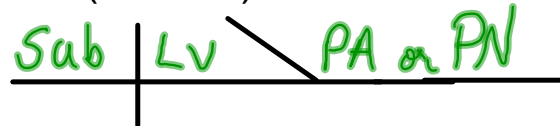
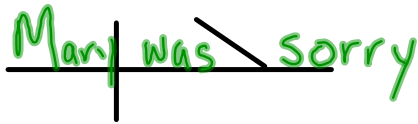

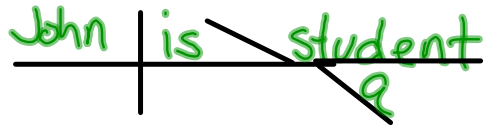
LV → PA / PN (aka SC)

PP

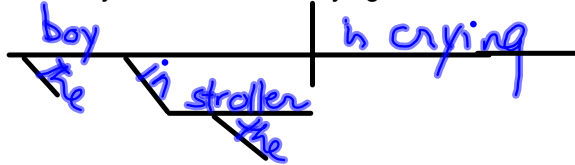
Determine if PP is adjective or adverb

If adjective, PP goes under noun or pronoun that it modifies.

If adverb, PP goes under verb, adj. or adverb that it modifies.

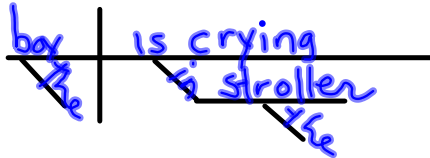
Adjective PP:

Adverb PP:

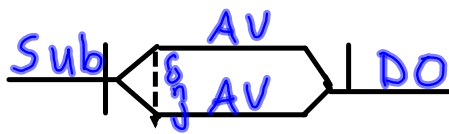
The boy is crying in the stroller.



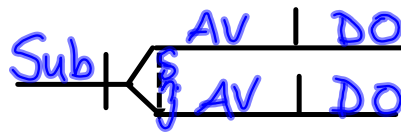

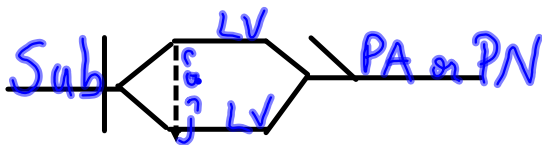
Compound AVs with shared DO



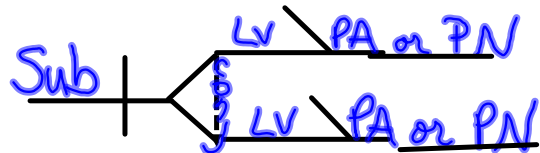
Compound AVs with own DO



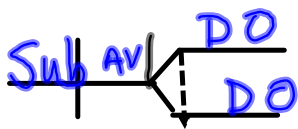
Compound LVs with shared PA / PN



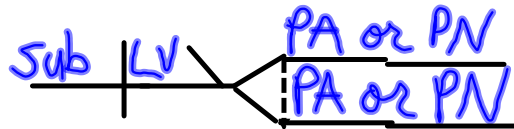
Compound LVs with own PA / PN



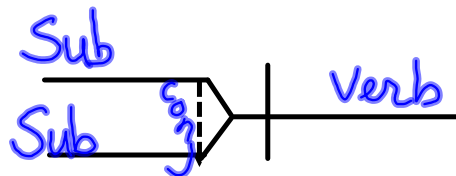
Compound DO (after AV)
