## Subject and Object Pronouns

### Subject Pronouns

I  
we  
you  
he  
she  
it  
they

**Can be used as subject of sentence  
or follow LV as Subject Complement (PN)**

We came home yesterday.

It was he who broke the glass.

### Object Pronouns

me  
us  
you  
him  
her  
it  
them

**Can be used after AV (either DO or IO)  
or in PP (as object of the preposition)**

The dog bit me.

That belongs to her.

## SUBJECT PRONOUNS

used as the subject of a clause (subj + verb)

as a PN after a LV

Examples:

<sup>S</sup> Mary <sup>V</sup> is older than <sup>S</sup> Sue <sup>V</sup> is.

<sup>S</sup> She <sup>V</sup> is older than Sue <sup>S</sup> is. <sup>V</sup>

<sup>S</sup> Mary <sup>V</sup> is older than <sup>S</sup> she <sup>V</sup> is.

<sup>S</sup> Mary <sup>V</sup> is older than <sup>S</sup> she.

Examples:

The most popular student <sup>LV</sup> was <sup>PN</sup> Tom.

The most popular student <sup>LV</sup> was <sup>PN</sup> he.

<sup>LV</sup> It was <sup>PN</sup> Susan who saved the squirrel.

<sup>LV</sup> It was <sup>PN</sup> she who saved the squirrel.

# OBJECT PRONOUNS

INDIRECT OBJECT

OBJECT OF PP

Examples:

Susan <sup>AV</sup> hugged <sup>DO</sup> Tom.

Susan <sup>AV</sup> hugged <sup>DO</sup> him.

Tom <sup>AV</sup> baked <sup>IO</sup> Susan <sup>DO</sup> some cookies.

Tom <sup>AV</sup> baked <sup>IO</sup> her <sup>DO</sup> some cookies.

Tom gave the cookies to Susan.

Tom gave the cookies to her.
