Subject Verb who or what? to for

Mom baked cookies.

S AV IO DO to for US

Mom baked early in the day.

S AV ADJ DO

John washed his car.

John gave his car a bath on Saturday.

HV + MV

REMEMBER: final OR only verb is the MAIN VERB; all others before the MV are helping verbs. Can have up to 3 HVs for each MV

MV

I did my homework.

HV MV

Can I do my homework later?

HV HV MV

Should I have finished my homework by now?

HV HV HV MV

I could have been doing my homework.

Susan is happy.

S LV SC (PN)
Susan is a happy girl.

S LV SC (PN)
Tom is the smartest student in our class.

S LV SC (PA)
Tom seems worried about the test.

I looked at the test.

feel

AV

Tom felt lonely.

Susan felt the kitten's
soft fur.

taste

AV

The lemon tasted sour.

Mary tasted the sour
lemonade.

sound

AV

The song sounds familiar.	The church sounded the bells at midnight.
<i>"sounds" can be changed to "is"</i>	<i>"sounded" can be changed to "rang"</i>
