Use a **subject pronoun** in a compound subject. Use an **object pronoun** in a compound direct object, compound indirect object, or compound object of a preposition. If you are unsure which pronoun form to use, say the sentence to yourself without the other part of the compound. For example, *Aiden and me did an Internet search* becomes *Me did an Internet search*. You can hear that *me* should be replaced with *I*.
