7. The Manx, a breed that originated on the Isle of Man in the Irish Sea, usually has no tail.

9. The Siamese is a breed with a colorpoint coat, a coat with contrasting patches of color on the face, ears, tail, and feet.
10. A tabby coat, one with patterns of dark stripes, is often found on American shorthair cats.
11. The Scottish fold, a breed with ears that fold down, originated in Scotland.
12. The largest breed, the Maine coon cat, resembles a raccoon.
13. Crossbreeds, cats with characteristics from more than one breed, are often healthier than purebred cats.
14. Animal shelters, which are found in most communities, are excellent places to find a cat.
15. The cats at a shelter, crossbreeds as well as cats of different breeds, need a good home.
